Adoption Process

Public Review and Comment

Several avenues were used to disseminate the draft plan for public review and comment. First of all, CD copies of the plan were distributed to each local municipality. A printed version was placed at each library in the County and in the County Clerk's office. The draft plan was posted on NEMCOG's web site. A newspaper article and notice informed county residents of the completed draft plan, where it could be reviewed and when the County Board of Commissioners would be considering approval.

Upon final approval of this plan by Federal Emergency Management Agency this hazard mitigation plan will be presented to the Cheboygan County Board of Commissioners, the Cheboygan City Council, the Mackinaw City and Wolverine Village Councils and each Township Board of Trustees for their review and adoption.

During development of this plan several presentations were made to local officials from the various governmental units of Cheboygan County. The purpose of these presentations was to describe the hazard mitigation planning process, conclusions and identify possible projects and actions.

Plan Implementation

Implementation Process

The Cheboygan County Hazard Mitigation Plan will be reviewed by the Charlevoix/Cheboygan/ Emmet Office of Emergency Management on an ad-hoc basis, or as directed by the Cheboygan County Board of Commissioners, during a period not to exceed five-years from the date of adoption. The Charlevoix/Cheboygan/Emmet Office of Emergency Management may provide references and assistance for specific mitigating strategies to units of County government and outside entities.

Process for Monitoring, Evaluating and Updating

Monitoring and Evaluation

The Cheboygan County Hazard Mitigation Plan will be reviewed by the Charlevoix/ Cheboygan/Emmet Office of Emergency Management on an ad-hoc basis, or as directed by the Cheboygan County Board of Commissioners, during a period not to exceed five-years from the date of adoption. Effectiveness of the Hazard Mitigation Planning process will be evaluated every five years.

The Disaster Mitigation Act (DMA) of 2000 requires the Cheboygan County Hazard Mitigation Plan be updated every five years. This may include updating community profiles, examining goals, redoing the hazard analysis and revisiting the project list. *In order to properly update the plan, Cheboygan County will need to seek funding from appropriate state and federal agencies.* Any update would require public comment, county approval, local jurisdictional approval if projects are located or proposed in a particular township, and approval by the State of Michigan and FEMA.

Process to Incorporate into Local Planning Activities

Cheboygan County, townships, as well as, local and state agencies will be encouraged to consider integrating information from the Hazard Mitigation plan into their respective comprehensive and operations plans. In the future, as the county updates it's master plan, it is encouraged to consider incorporating appropriate hazard mitigation information into the county's master plan. As a part of the education and outreach aspect of the hazard mitigation effort, communities will also be encouraged to adopt zoning regulations that will minimize effects of hazards.

Ongoing Public Participation

Cheboygan County is committed to involving the public in implementing and updating of the Hazard Mitigation Plan. Copies of the plan will be available at the county clerk's office and all township offices. The plan contains the address and phone number of the Emergency Management Office, which will be responsible for keeping a record of public comments on the plan.

Information related to the plan will be posted on a community web site or regional planning agency web site. The web page will contain the mailing address, phone number and email address of the appropriate contact person.

WHEREAS, Cheboygan County, Michigan has experienced disasters that have damaged commercial, residential, and public properties, displaced citizens and businesses, closed streets and bridges, and presented general public health and safety concerns; and

WHEREAS, Cheboygan County has prepared a *Hazard Mitigation Plan* that outlines the County's options to reduce overall damage and impact from natural hazards; and

WHEREAS, the *Hazard Mitigation Plan* has been reviewed by County residents, business owners, and federal state, and local agencies, and has been revised to reflect their concerns;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT

1. The *Cheboygan County Hazard Mitigation Plan* is hereby adopted as an official plan of Cheboygan County, Michigan.

2. A hazard mitigation planning Committee is hereby established as a permanent county advisory body. The County Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) shall function as the Hazard Mitigation Committee. The Committee's duties shall be designated in the *Hazard Mitigation Plan*.

3. The Hazard Mitigation Committee is charged with supervising implementation of the Plan's recommendations within the funding limitations as provided by the Cheboygan County Board of Commissioners or other sources.

4. The Hazard Mitigation Committee shall give priority attention to action items recommended by the *Hazard Mitigation Plan* as high priority. :

5. The Hazard Mitigation Committee's facilitator shall convene the Hazard Mitigation Committee at least once per year. The Committee shall monitor implementation of the plan and shall submit a written progress report to the County Board of Commissioners in accordance with the following format:

- a. A review of the original plan.
- b. A review of any disasters or emergencies that occurred during the previous calendar year.
- c. A review of the actions taken, including what was accomplished during the previous year.
- d. A discussion of any implementation problems.
- e. Recommendations for new projects or revised action items. Such recommendations shall be subject to approval by the County Board of Commissioners.
