Q10 Do you think the non-motorized trail network and trail amenities in the Albert Township area should be expanded and promoted more?

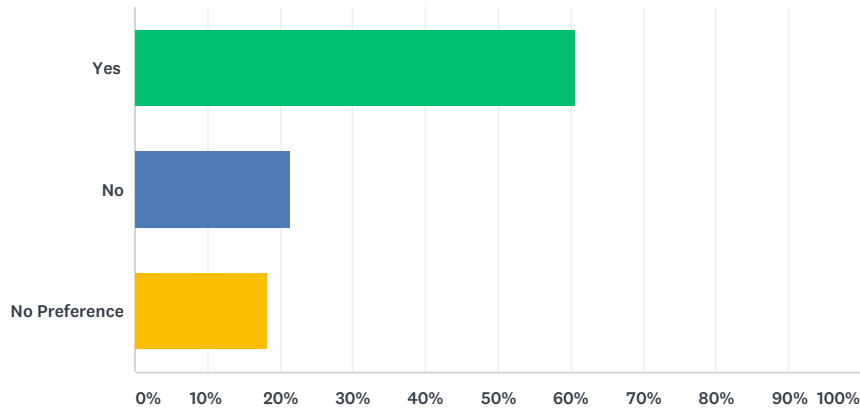

Q11 Do you think the motorized trail network and trail amenities in the Albert Township area should be expanded and promoted more?

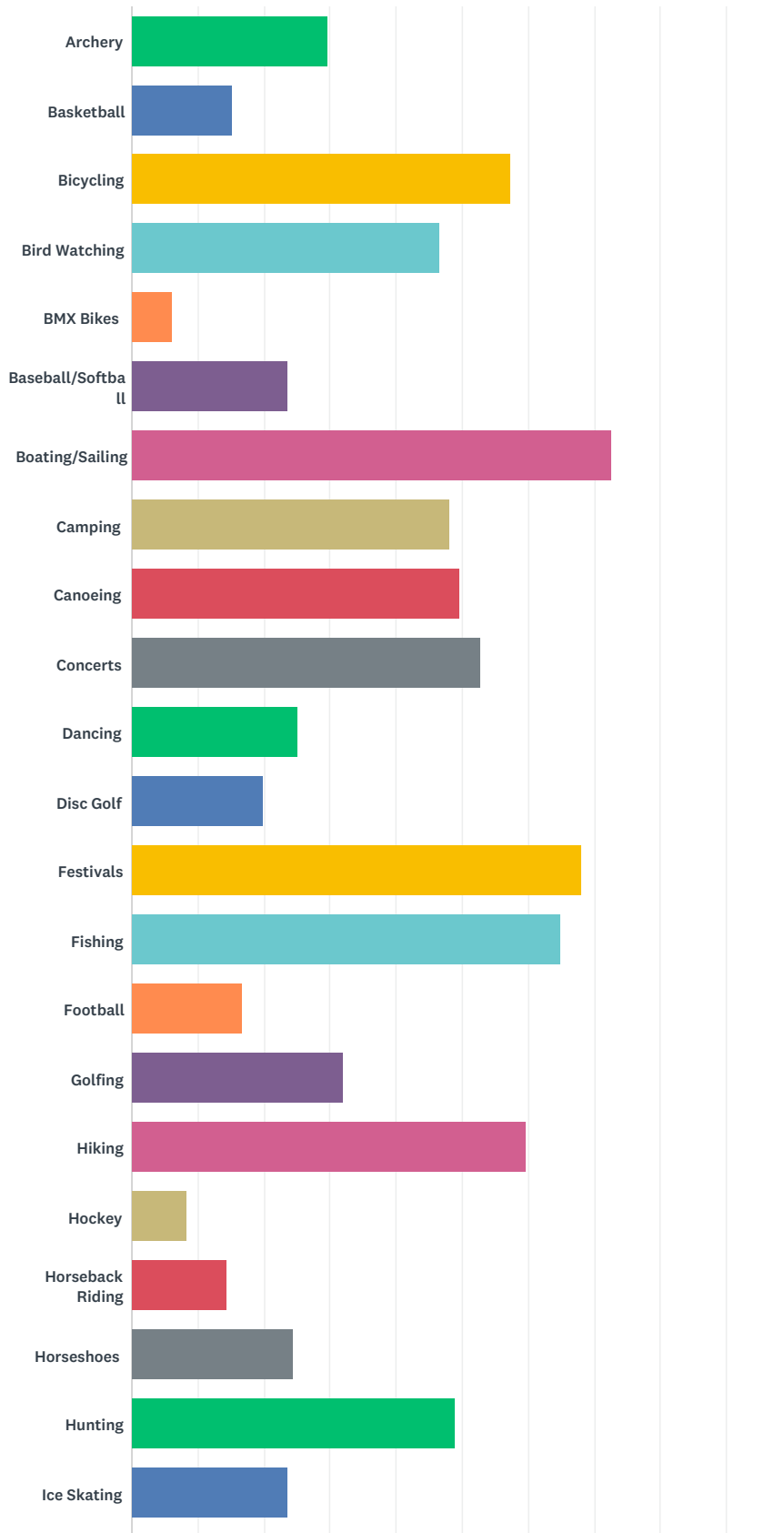
