* Tourism & recreation based businesses include watercraft sales and service, taverns, and clubs, hotel dining rooms, family restaurants, fast food restaurants, sporting goods, hotel and motel sales tax and hotel and motel use tax.

Note: Data consist of the sales and use tax collected in Northeast Mich counties for the years indicated. Sales tax for the years 1986-1994 was a flat 4% on gross proceeds from retail sales of tangible personal property. In 1995 the sales tax went up to 6%. For the years 1986-1994, the use tax included a 4% tax levied on the sale of transient hotel or motel room rentals. went up to 6%.

Data Limitations: While tourism and recreation expenditures account for the majority of the sales in the businesses included in this table, they include an undetermined amount of sales to residents, as well. The sales and use tax owed by franchise corporations (e.g. Holiday Inns) are paid in a lump sum by the corporate headquarters. If franchise businesses do a significant share of the business in a given county, the sales and use tax data for that county underestimates the volume of this business activity. Businesses are classified by their principal business activity (e.g. hotel or restaurant). Many businesses, however, engage in a variety of sales activities. Thus the sales and use tax collections recorded under various classifications may not include the payments of all enterprises involved in some way in the type of business included in that category.
