





Sunrise Coast

Sparkling lakes, majestic Lake Huron, mysterious shipwrecks, historic lighthouses, pristine beaches... treasures to be found along Michigan's 200-mile Sunrise Coast.

The Lake Huron Shores Good Roads Association was formed in 1933 to finish the Huron Stores. Highway, now US-23, that linked Bay Chy and Mackinaw City. A promotional effort enlisted locpeople, businesses, and donations to construct this rural route. By June 20, 1933 analonally acclaimed through-route had been completed. All along it are scenic views of Lake Huron, 5,000 miles of crystal clear rives and streams, and mor that 3,000 water bodies avails travelers along the Surnise Coast (US-32). Beginy your journey at a historic train depot in Standsh and wind your way or the Lake Huron coast to the majestic Mackina Bridge at the Straits of Mackinac, where the sponling bluegereen waters of Lake Huron and Lake Sunrise Coast include 16 lighthouses, hundreds of miles of hising biding, sking, horseback riding, and motor trails, unique museums, true up north small towns, cottages, live performances, wine tasting, and fine dining.

The adventures continue beyond the coust. Connecting to US-33 byway in Oscoda is the River Road National Scenic Byway, which wholds along the mightly AuStable River through the Huron National Forest. (For more information on the River Road Byway, see page 1.) Coastal and Inland discoveries awaits, so get back to the water on the Sunrise Coast.









This park, with spectacular Lake Huron views, is located 10 miles north of Alpena. Situated on the Alpena/Presque Isle County line, east of US 23, the property covers nearly 6 square miles. The park features an inactive limestone quarry, a deep water harbor with boat launch, trails, parking and picnic areas, 8 large and several small sinkholes and miles of forested land. michigan.gov/rockport



Bike, walk, roller blade and skateboard on the 18+ miles of paved pathway and access all of the waterfront parks in the city. The Bi-Path follows along the top of the breakwall at the marina, allowing an unobstructed view of Lake Huron. Follow the shore of the Thunder Bay River through the Alpena County Fairgrounds. The Bi-Path winds through downtown Alpena spanning the Thunder

Bay River connecting the Maritime Heritage Trail to Rotary Island and the Marina, among other landmarks. The bike path continues south to Starlite Beach and Miche-ke-wis park past the southern business district. Bike rentals are available at the Great Lakes Maritime Heritage Center. alpena.mi.us

Island Park - Alpena Wildlife Sanctuary



A 17-acre island jewel surrounded by the Thunder Bay River which winds through the 500-acre wildlife sanctuary of water, low islands and waterfowl Several paths lead through varied ecosystems including sand dunes, meadows, woodlands, gentle slopes, and marsh areas. Viewing and fishing platforms (one handicapped-accessible viewing platform) are located at various points on the island. Kavak/canoe rentals and launch site available.

10 miles north of Alpena on Long Lake, this 68acre county park has 105 campsites adjacent to 5,652 acres of water. Water and electricity are available at 80 of these sites with the other 25 sites considered primitive. Park facilities include restrooms/showers, dumping station, concession stand, concrete boat ramp, three docks, nature trails, two pavilions (with electricity), picnic tables,

two playgrounds, two swimming beaches, and outdoor trailer storage. Special activities include an annual pig roast and a weekly pot luck dinner. Open May 15 to Sept 15. Camping is permitted after Sept 15 until Nov. 1 on a daily rate schedule. A alpenacounty.org park caretaker is on-site.

Special Highlight

Standish Historic Depot & US 23 Welcome Center

The Standish Historic Depot is often a traveler's first stop along the Sunrise Coast, so we want to highlight this historic gem which has been renovated into a Welcome Center for the US 23 Heritage Route!

Between 1880 and 1910, the Michigan Central Railroad (MCRR) decided to replace many of its Michigan depots. The MCRR extelled the virtues of its two stations in an 1890 publication: "The buildings that strike the traveler most forcibly, however, are the new railroad stations..their manifest beauty and appropriateness, their admirable construction, and convenient arrangement for the purposes of their use..make them models of railroad architecture ... all [the buildings] are thoroughly harmonious, and suggest the comfort, the convenience, and even the cozy pretiness to be found in the internal arrangement, furnishing, and decoration. The Standish Depot, constructed in 1889, was one of these new stations."



Early history

The original depot was built in 1871 (south of M-61) just after the Lansing, lackson and Saginaw Railroad finished a new line north of Bay City to Wells. The City of Standish was platted around the railroad line, so the railroad was the key to the community's growth and success. After the MCRR leased the line in 1871, it built

new lines across the state, reaching Mackinaw City ten years later. With Detroit naw linked to most of the Lower Peninsula, the MCRR could focus on improving the passenger experience. When the citizens of Standish asked for a new depot, MCRR told them they would receive a completely new structure if they supplied the stone. Local farmers answered the call and brought wagon loads of large field stones to the site. Site grading was finished for a grand total of 51,000, and construction began in May of 1889. The entire building was finished the week of October 13, 1889. A newspaper article proclaimed the new Depot "a little daisy."

Depot a great community asset

The Depot was more than a transportation hub. The area in front of the Depot -the "Depot Park"- served as a community gathering place. In the 1910's a wood bandstand was moved to the grounds. A Bay City Times article from 1892 stated: "The MCRR have done much, and are continuing the good work, to make Standish the largest, liveliest, and best town on their road north of Bay City; and have spent more than \$10,000 there in the past year, their store passenger depot alone costing \$5,000."

Designers and builders


The architect for the Standish Depot was probably Frederick Spier of the well-known Detroit firm of Spier and Rohns. This firm designed many Michigan depots including Dexter and Niles, and a number of imposing Detroit landmarks like the Chamber of Commerce Building. The Standish Depot is a modest yet fashionable example of the Richardsonian Romaneque Syle, popularized by the famous architect Henry Hobson Richardson of Boston. Detroit contractors Nelson J. Rogers and Robert M. Adams were in charge of the construction. Adams and Rogers built the Dexter Depot in late 1880's, so they were already familiar with Spier and Rohns designs. A year after the Standish Depot was finished, Rogers collaborated with another contractor to build a twin depot in Lawton.



End of the rail era

In the 1880's a total of eight trains stopped daily; by 1929 the number had dropped to four. Over time, the road in front of the Depot served more traffic than the railroad. In the 1940's the Fletcher Oil Company built a gas station in front of the Depot, bringing the number of gas stations along "Gasoline Alley" to seventeen. The Standish Depot served passengers until the 1960's and freight traffic until 1972. The Depot was home to a variety of enterprises in later years, including a real estate office, but all of the occupants left the building features largely intact. Due to its fine condition, the important role it played in the history of Standish, and the architecture of the building itself, the Depot was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1991.

Today the depot has been restored and contains railroad and local memorabilia. The depot serves as the southern Welcome Center for the US 23 Heritage Route!

💦 Starlite Beach & Mich-e-ke-wis Park 🛛 🛧 🗻

A wonderful, large, open beach with a splashpad, large playground, barbeque pits, picnic tables, and bathroom facilities/outdoor showers. The beach looks out onto Lake Huron providing beautiful scenery. Located within a few minute walk of restaurants and stores. Located on US 23 (State Ave).

🖌 Alpena Bi-Path 🦹 🛧 🖧

The Alpena Bi-Path is a beautiful city-wide paved pathway accommodating both walking and biking. It's a great way to see the City of Alpena and all the great things it has to offer. The Bi- Path connects almost every park in the city as well as many of the other attractions including the Besser Museum, Thunder Bay Recreation Center, Marina, the Thunder Bay National Marine Sanctuary, and many more. Many of the parks throughout the city provide great spots to park a car and head out on the trail by foot or bike. Shipwreck buoys are viewable from the Maritime Heritage Trail (part of the Bi-Path system). The Bi-Path is accessible from numerous parks throughout Alpena.

5 Bayview Park

This city park adjacent to the marina has a playground, tennis courts, and a spectacular view! The bandshell also serves as the focal point for many community concerts and events! From US 23 (State Ave) heading north in Alpena, turn right at Pretriss Street.

Located at the mouth of the Thunder Bay River, the 80-foot skeletal tower has been called "Sputnik" (resembles the Russian space satellite) and "Little Red" by locals. It is said this oft dismissed light is "long on duty, short on beauty." Believed to be the only lighthouse of this type in the U.S. the station was built of wood in 1877, rebuilt of wood in 1888, and finally constructed of steel in 1914. An automated active aid to navigation, the Alpena Light originally housed a sth Order Fresnel lens. From US 23 (State Are) heading north in Alpena, turn right at Prentiss St (next to Bay View Park). Head out onto the breakwall to view Little Red.

🕄 Great Lakes Maritime Heritage Center 🏔

Explore the exhibits at the Great Lakes Maritime Heritage Center. Experience the maritime history, shipwrecks, and archaeology of the Great Lakes, and much more. Walk the deck of a life-sized schooner battling the Great Lakes storm and then dive in and explore a shipwreck—without getting wet! The sanctuary is dedicated to protecting the Great Lakes and their rich history. From US 23 heading north, turn right onto 2nd Ave and cross the bridge. Turn left onto Fletcher St. See page 24 for more information on the Thunder Bay National Marine Sanctuary.

😒 Island Park & Wildlife Sanctuary 🥻 🚮

Island Park and Wildlife Sanctuary, a 17-acre Island jewel surrounded by the Thunder Bay River, winds through 500 acres of back waters and low islands. Located in the heart of Alpena, several footpaths wind along the island's perimeter and the interior and leads joggers, walkers, photographers, fishermen, and nature lovers through varied ecosystems including sand dunes, meadows, woodlands, gentle slopes, and marsh areas. Viewing platforms are universally-accessible. There is a universally-accessible canoe/Royak/paddleboard launch providing access to the wildlife santuarcy that surrounds the island.*Corner of US 23 and Long Rapids Rd*.

🗩 💽 Besser Museum for Northeast Michigan 🔓

The Besser Museum offers educational experiences in art, history, and science. Visitors will be delighted by the Museum's eight-acre campus with a historic village, full-dome planetarium, Foucault pendulum, Devonian fossil pit - where visitors can keep all the fossil they find, rotating art galleries featuring both local, regional and nationally renowned artifacts from early man! An exhibit on regional resources and the flourishing industries that contributed to the development of Northeest Michigan is also featured. 491 Johnson Street. From US 23 north in Alpana, turn right onto Johnson St. bessernusuem.org

Alpena Shipwreck Tours

Explore the shipwrecks of the Thunder Bay National Marine Sanctuary on the 65-foot glass-bottomed Lady Michigan! Two large viewing wells on the main deck give passengers a front row view of shipwrecks on the bottom of Lake Huron. Departing from the port of Alpena, the Lady Michigan will take you on a comfortable adventure into the heart of Lake Huron's Shipwreck Alley. Daily tours begin in June and continue through the color season. Tickets can be purchased online, by calling 888-469-4696, or at the Sanctuary Gift Store located at 500 W. Fletcher Street in Alpena, The Lady Michigan docks just behind the Heritage Center. Group and private charters are welcome.





The project was begun in 2008 as a way for the community to share its unique history with visitors. A committee was formed and construction of guilt square blocks began. Eight blocks were mounted during the summer of 2008 in the eastern half of Alcona County. Twenty more were put up in 2009 to create a trail that encompasses every township in Alcona County

This historic building began life as the Alcona House Hotel, circa 1856, and is one of only four original buildings in town that have survived early fires. The structure has also been a pharmacy with soda fountain, an appliance store, and a furniture refinisher. Their Quilt Trail block, the "Economy Block", reflects the building's business history,

Crick Home S01 N. State St. (US 23), Harrisville, MI 48740

This home was built in 1907, and the building that is now the garage (where their block is mounted) was originally built as a stable in 1908. Their block, the "Mill Wheel", was chosen as their property crosses the old mill pond. The state-owned waterway is a tributary that feeds into Lake Huron.

Cedarbrook Trout Farm 1543 N. Lakeshore Dr., Harrisville, MI 48740 989-724-5241

Bait & equipment furnished, no license required. Hours: Open 7 days, 12-6 p.m., Father's Day thru Labor Day. Then Sat & Sun, 12-5 p.m. thru Oct. 15; then closed till spring.

Located on what used to be the main road along the Lake Huron shoreline, this place has long been a watering spot for native Americans, trappers, explorers and logging teams. 75 years ago, Cedarbrook became the first licensed fish farm in Michigan; it's been owned by Jerry and Michelle Kahn for 38 years. Their Quilt Trail block depicts their customer - a child in overalls with a fishing pole.

Alcona Township Black River Park

Located south of the Intersection of Lakeshore Dr. and Black River Rd. This park is a popular recreation area for locals and visitors allke. Their Quilt Trail block signifies the annual "Black River Bridge Walk" which takes place on Labor Day every year - significantly shorter than the larger up-north one!

5 Benghauser farm 4028 Black River Rd., Black River, MI 48721

The Fontaine family came from Canada in the late 1800's to settle in Black River. They bought 80 acres and built a log cabin in the area that is now the center of the circular drive. In 1892 they built the present two-story farmhouse and soon after bought the remaining 40 acres adjoining the farm to the Huron National Forest. In 1954 the Floyd Benghauser family purchased the 120 acres and added another 80 acres in the early 1960's. Working with the Michigan Forestry Dept. and the DNR in the 1960's, "Beng" Benghauser began a series of conservation programs; among them were three tree plantations on the property, hence the "Pine Tree" quilt block.

Spruce Presbyterian Church 5230 Gillard Rd., Spruce, MI 48762

Originally called Caledonia Presbyterian Church after the township it is located in, the church was organized in 1888 by settlers of mostly Scottish and Swedish descent. Rev. Boyce was the longest-serving pastor, from 1901 until 1933 with the exception of six years. On the night of Oct. 1, 1933 the white clapboard church burned to the ground, the cause of the fire is unknown. In December 1933 Rev. Boyce died. The Gothic-style fieldstone church was built & rededicated in 1936. "Cross & Crown" is their Quilt Trail block.


7 Holsworth farm 6195 F-41, Spruce, MI 48762

Pull in the driveway for a safe view of the barn off the busy roadway. A Michigan Centennial Farm, this property is now owned by Ramona Clark-Holsworth and Jim Holsworth. The barn was built in 1921 by George S. Snowden, grandfather to the late Harold Clark. Harold and his father Thomas raced horses in Alpena in the 1950's. There have always been horses on the farm; today they are kept for pleasure riding. Their Quilt Trail block features a horse's head in the center of a log cabin, as horses are the center of their farm life. Quilt Trail stops continued on back..


